
- WTD REAR DOOR MOLLE PANEL (FES-MP-PRD)

1 HARDWARE (FES-MP-RD-H)



- 2 1/4 WASHER
- 2 1/4-20 NYLOCK NUT

TOOLS NEEDED:

PHILIPS SCREW DRIVER DRILL 1/4 DRILL BIT RAZOR BLADE 1/4 ALLEN BIT BLUE PAINTERS TAPE SHARRPIE TAPE MEASURER

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

INSTALLATION

STEP 1:

With the drivers side door open, remove the door locking pin by unscrewing it



STEP 2:

Now remove the upper plastic portion by pulling it out of the metal clips



STEP 3:

Remove screws from lower panel as well as handle if van has one



INSTALLATION

STEP 4:

Now lift up on lower panel to remove it

Be sure to disconnect the wiring as well



STEP 5:

Remove the speaker to gain access to the location of mounting bracket



STEP 6:

Center bracket on the door and drill $\ensuremath{^{1\!\!/}}$ hole for hardware



INSTALLATION

STEP 7:

With holes drilled place mounting bracket over hole and insert threaded aluminum bracket under door sheet metal and start threading 1/4 -20 hardware into mounting plate.

*Note: Do not tighten these screws, just get them started in the holes



STEP 8:

Re-install speaker and wiring



STEP 9:

Measure the lower mounting bracket and trim the top center lower plastic accrodingly

9 3/8 = top left corner to the edge 15 3/4 = Top Center



INSTALLATION

STEP 10:

Be sure to get all clips in the door and slide panel down

With lower panel installed, now tighten 1/4 allen bolts



STEP 11:

When inserting the upper panel, trim the lower plastic to fit, and re-install again



STEP 12:

Mount molle panel to lower mount using 1/4-20 allen bolts



INSTALLATION

STEP 13:

Take upper mounting panel and align with molle panel to determine where it will be mounted

Using the 2 self taping screws, drill through the plastic in the sheet metal of the door



STEP 14:

Now use 1/4-20 bolts to attach the molle panel to the upper mounting bracket and tighten

Congratulations! You've just installed the WTD Rear Door Molle Panel. Time to hang some goodies on it!
